Once a medieval city, Saint-Emilion has always been a model of respect for the earth and this is reflected in its highly prized wines. Its ancient origins, the archaeological treasures found throughout the city, are the main reasons for our environmental commitment.

During our renovations, we try to make choices that support sustainable development – We mainly work with local artisans. The same philosophy applies to cleaning where we use only eco-friendly products and steam generator Vapodil.

Our lighting is equipped with low consumption bulbs. Our waste oil is collected.

Our teams are aware of the economical management of water, energy and waste.

Even with small behavioural changes such as reducing our car journeys or turning down the heating, we are committed to the reduction of the emission of greenhouse gases on a daily basis.

We also work very closely with both our suppliers and the town committee to find new solutions to develop recycling and the use of less packaging.

Transport and travel solutions also have a low environmental impact such as trains, public transport and bicycles. Saint-Emilion can be reached quickly from Paris by choosing the train with the high-speed line that leads to Bordeaux or Libourne near Saint-Emilion. E-bikes can be rented to ride around the vineyard.

All these steps will help us to follow the principles of sustainable development and we hope that you will share in this challenge by endorsing our choices.
